



STANDARD FELINE SPAY FEES

Pre-anesthetic Bloodwork (under 6 years) **\$84.50**
 (6 years and older) **\$201.00**

Pre-anesthetic bloodwork allows our doctors to “take a look” inside your pet before surgery is begun. Depending on the age of your pet, different protocols are followed. Pre-anesthetic bloodwork checks liver and kidney enzymes, glucose and protein levels, complete blood count, and platelet count. Patients over 6 years old will receive more comprehensive bloodwork.

IV Catheter and Perioperative Fluids **\$36.00**

We place an IV catheter in the cephalic vein of one of the front legs prior to surgery. A small area of hair on the front leg will be shaved in order for us to properly sanitize the area before placing the IV catheter. Fluids are given via IV catheter throughout surgery. Fluid therapy helps maintain blood pressure and allows the anesthetics to be flushed out faster, so your pet recovers as safe and as quickly as possible.

Anesthesia **\$190.00**

A very safe sedative is given via intramuscular injection just prior to surgery. This sedative completely anesthetizes the cat. We are also able to reverse this particular sedative if needed, such as if your cat is slow to wake up following surgery.

Feline Spay **\$30.00**

A feline spay is an ovariohysterectomy. The uterus and ovaries are removed, therefore permanently preventing pregnancy and reducing the risk of mammary cancer.

Antibiotic Injection **\$55.00**

Antibiotics serve to prevent post-operative infection. We give cats an injection of Convenia, an extended—release antibiotic injection. Convenia is “convenient” in that you will not have to give a tablet or liquid medication by mouth to your cat!

*Price may increase for cats over 10 pounds.

A feline spay is an ovariohysterectomy. The uterus and ovaries are removed, therefore permanently preventing pregnancy and reducing the risk of mammary cancer. Surgical Monitoring **\$20.00**

Your pet is connected to an ECG machine to monitor heart rate and rhythm throughout surgery. A pulse oximeter also monitors blood oxygen saturation. A technician also closely monitors your pet throughout surgery and in recovery.

Pain Injection **\$31.00**

A pain injection will help ease pain after surgery. Our pain injections are classified as NSAIDs (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug). These drugs are safe for surgical patients.

Lidocaine Block **\$25.00 ()**

Declaw with Laser **\$157.00 ()**

The declaw is the permanent surgical removal of the cat’s nails. In this surgery, a laser rather than a scalpel blade is used to disarticulate the third toe bone. Advantages of laser surgery include virtually no bleeding (during surgery or afterwards), less post-operative pain, and in many cases, no bandages. *Price includes extra anesthesia time.

Yesterday’s News (for declaws) **\$12.00 ()**

Yesterday’s News is a cat litter that is safe for use after surgery, and is made from recycled newspaper. (5 lbs)

Over Night Stay Pre- OR Post-Surgery **Free ()**

Let us pamper your pet and provide a calm, quiet, and comfortable environment either the night before surgery or the night following surgery. **Required for declaws**

*This is for drop-off patients only. If your pet is having a procedure done while boarding, normal boarding rates will apply.



E-Collar **\$10-20.00 ()**

An e-collar will prevent your cat from chewing at sutures and/or licking the incision site. If you believe your cat is likely to exhibit these behaviors, you may want us to send an e-collar home with you. We will be more than happy to fit your pet with the appropriate size e-collar, and show you how to put it on your cat if needed.

Home Again Microchip **\$50.00 ()**

A Home Again Microchip is the best way to provide permanent identification for your pet. The chip is inserted via syringe, and each chip has its own unique number to identify your pet. If your pet ever wanders off and is taken to either a shelter or veterinary clinic, your pet’s number will show up on the microchip scanner and we can much more easily get your pet back home again.

At-Home Pain Management **\$50.00 ()**

If you would like to ensure that your pet is pain-free following her surgery, we can send home a tablet or liquid form of the NSAID drug we use for pain injections.
